- YES, these count: ebooks, audiobooks, graphic novels
- No, these do not count: magazines, movies, television

Can I participate without a computer/phone?

- Yes! Paper slips will be available at the Reference Desk.
- Fill out a paper entry slip, give it to a librarian, and we will add your book for you.
- Your books will be visible on the Summer Reading website, but you will not need to use the website yourself.

Can I participate without entering the library?

- Yes! The raffles are entirely online.
- The library will not mail prizes, but we will arrange for curbside pickup.


